## Virtual HPV Symposium & Expert Panel

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4th, 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm

### Target Audience: Medical and Dental Professionals, Medical and Dental Residents, Nurses, Health Professions Students, Politicians

This virtual symposium will provide evidence-based information about HPV and its related cancers including clinical stories and photos of the morbidity associated with HPV-associated cancers and their treatment. The presenters will highlight head and neck and cervical cancer. There will also be a focus on HPV vaccination as cancer prevention and guidance on how to talk to patients and parents about the vaccine. Following each presentation there will be a question and answer session with the expert panelists which include a dental oncologist, an OB/GYN, a pharmacist, and an American Cancer Society representative.

### Objectives:

1. Educate medical and dental professionals, residents, students, nurses and politicians about the facts of HPV, how to prevent it, and the possible sequelae if preventive measures aren't taken.
2. Provide the best strategies for medical professionals to discuss HPV with patients and encourage the vaccine.
3. Utilize a panel of HPV experts to answer any questions from medical professionals and politicians about HPV and the HPV Vaccine.
